Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by June 30, 2021

By June 30, 2021 job offices registered altogether 273,302 job seekers. That is by 12,250 less than at the end of May. The number of job seekers increased by 3,665 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 253,940.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 28,463 newcomers. That is by 96 job seekers less than in the preceding month and by 10,041 newly registered job seekers less than in June of the preceding year.

In June, job offices registration was terminated with 40,983 job seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 28,525 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 12,458 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly decrease of unemployed was registered by all 77 districts – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts Jeseník (17.8 %), Jindřichův Hradec (14.7 %), Prostějov (11.2 %), Český Krumlov (11.1 %), Benešov (10.6 %), Prachatice (9.8 %), Cheb (9.3 %), Břeclav (9.3 %).

By June 30, 2021, 9,448 school leavers with all levels of education and juveniles were registered. Thus they share in the total unemployment by 3.5% (May 2021-3.8%, June 2020-3.3%).

At the end of June, job offices registered 142,733 female job seekers, that is 52.2 % of the unemployed in total, and 39,318 persons with reduced working capacity, that is 14.4 % of the unemployed in total.

In June 2021, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 75,234 job seekers, that is 27.5 % of all job seekers under registration (May 2021 – 28.4%, June 2020 – 34.6 %).

By June 30, 2021, there were 13,634 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.

By June 30, 2021, the share of unemployed was 3.7 % (May 2021 – 3.9 %, June 2020 – 3.7 %), time series - https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 28 districts, the highest being in Karviná (9.0 %), Most (7.3 %), Ostrava-město (6.7 %), Chomutov (6.3 %), Ústí nad Labem (6.3 %), Sokolov (6.1 %), Louny (5.7 %), Bruntál 5.7 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts of Pelhřimov (1.6 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.7 %), Praha-východ (1.9 %), Jičín (1.9 %), Jindřichův Hradec (1.9 %), Mladá Boleslav Benešov (2.0 %), Mladá Boleslav (2.0 %), Prachatice (2.1 %). Share of unemployed - men was 3.5 % and share of unemployed - women was 4.0 %.

By June 30, 2021, job offices registered altogether 355,612 vacancies. That is by 9,008 vacancies more than in the preceding month and by 20,708 vacancies more than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.8 job seekers for one vacancy at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (10.2), Sokolov (5.3), Most (4.9), Ústí nad Labem (4.9), Bruntál (3.9), Děčín (3.0), Ostrava město (2.7), Znojmo (2.6), In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 13,686 vacancies for persons with

reduced working capacity that is 2.9 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 63,979 vacancies, that is 0.1 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT – ILO, NSA data) was 3.1 % in May 2021.
