## Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by November 30, 2024

By November 30, 2024 job offices registered altogether 290,425 job seekers. That is by 1,422 more than at the end of October. The number of job seekers increased by 27,199 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 267,815.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 38,039 newcomers. That is by 1,493 job seekers less than in the preceding month and by 698 newly registered job seekers less than in November of the preceding year.

In November, job offices registration was terminated with 36,617 seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 27,357 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 9,260 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly increase of unemployed was registered by 53 districts – relatively the greatest increase was monitored in districts Jeseník (7.9 %), Znojmo (6.3 %), Český Krumlov (6.2 %), Klatovy (5.8 %), Sokolov (5.3 %), Jičín (5.0 %), Břeclav (4.3 %), Písek (4.2 %). A monthly decrease of unemployed was registered by 24 districts – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts – Rychnov nad Kněžnou (2.0 %), Ústí nad Labem (2.0 %), území Hlavního města Prahy (1.8 %), Most (1.7 %), Teplice (1.6 %), Praha-západ (1.6 %), Tábor (1.6 %), Chomutov (1.5 %).

By November 30, 2024, 17,714 school leavers with all levels of education and juveniles were registered. Thus they share in the total unemployment by 6.1 % (October -6.6 %, November 2023 - 5.7 %).

At the end of November, job offices registered 157,191 female job seekers, that is 54.1 % of the unemployed in total, and 38,166 persons with reduced working capacity, that is 13.1 % of the unemployed in total.

In November 2024, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 86,128 job seekers, that is 29.7 % of all job seekers under registration (October – 29 %, November 2023 – 29.2 %).

By November 2024, there were 17 478 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.

By November 30, 2024, the share of unemployed was 3.9 % (October – 3.8 %, November 2023 – 3.5 %), time series - <a href="https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno">https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno</a>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 33 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.3 %), Most (8.2 %), Bruntál (7.0 %), Chomutov (6.8 %), Děčín (6.1 %), Ostrava-město (6.1 %), Louny (6.1 %), Sokolov (6.2 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts Praha-východ (1.4 %), Praha-západ (1.6 %), Plzeň-jih (2.1 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (2.1 %), Pelhřimov (2.3 %), Benešov (2.4 %), Zlín (2.5 %), Jičín (2.7 %).

Share of unemployed - men was  $3.5\,\%$  and share of unemployed - women was  $4.3\,\%$ .

By November 30, 2024, job offices registered altogether 255,641 vacancies. That is by 10,331 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 23,067 vacancies less than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 1.1 job seekers for one vacancy at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (11.0), Děčín (6.6), Hodonín (6.1), Bruntál (5.9), Most (4.6), Jeseník (4.2), Blansko (4.0), Jablonec nad Nisou (3.9).

In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 11,474 vacancies for persons with reduced working capacity that is 3.3 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 46,383 vacancies, that is 0.4 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT - ILO, NSA data) was 2.6 % in October 2024.
