

## **Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by September 30, 2022**

**By September 30, 2022 job offices registered altogether 256,380 job seekers.** That is by 4,627 more than at the end of August 2022. The number of job seekers decreased by 5,762 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 232,887.

**In the course of job offices registered altogether 49,340 newcomers.** That is by 7,016 job seekers more than in the preceding month and by 6,405 newly registered job seekers more than in September of the preceding year.

**In September, job offices registration was terminated with 44,713 job seekers.** New jobs have been taken up by 30,353 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 14,360 job seekers due to other reasons.

**A monthly increase of unemployed** was registered **by 66 districts** — relatively the greatest increase was monitored in districts Jindřichův Hradec (11.2 %), Česká Lípa (9.2 %), Benešov (7.3 %), Cheb (6.8 %), Prachatice (6.3 %), Chrudim (5.6 %), Jičín (5.6 %), Praha-východ (5.4 %). **A monthly decrease of unemployed** was registered **by 11 districts** — relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts Tábor (2.7 %), Semily (2.5 %), Brno-venkov (1.5 %), Jihlava (1.4 %), Domažlice (0.7 %), Rokycany (0.5 %), Žďár nad Sázavou (0.4 %), Hradec Králové (0.3 %).

**By September 30, 2022, 15,490 school leavers** with all levels of education **and juveniles were registered.** Thus they share in the total unemployment by 6.0 % (August 2022 – 4.1 %, September 2021 – 6.1 %).

**At the end of September, job offices registered 143,359 female job seekers,** that is 55.9 % of the unemployed in total, and **36,288 persons with reduced working capacity,** that is 14.2 % of the unemployed in total.

**In September 2022, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 74,566 job seekers,** that is 29.1 % of all job seekers under registration (August 2022 – 31.4 %, September 2021 – 28.6 %).

**By September 30, 2022, there were 13,170 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.**

**By September 30, 2022, the share of unemployed was 3.5 %** (August 2022 – 3.4 %, September 2021 – 3.5 %), time series - <https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 25 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.3 %), Most (6.7 %), Chomutov (6.2 %), Bruntál (5.7 %), Ústí nad Labem (5.7 %), Louny (5.4 %), Ostrava-město (5.3 %), Děčín (5.0 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts Praha-východ (1.5 %), Pelhřimov (1.8 %), Praha-západ (1.8 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.9 %), Benešov (1.9 %), Plzeň-jih (2.0 %), Jindřichův Hradec (2.0 %), Zlín (2.1 %).

**Share of unemployed - men was 3.0 % and share of unemployed - women was 4.0 %.**

**By September 30, 2022, job offices registered altogether 306,098 vacancies.** That is by 6,229 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 51,813 vacancies less than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.8 job seekers for one vacancy

at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (10.1), Ústí nad Labem (4.5), Bruntál (4.3), Most (4.1), Děčín (3.0), Sokolov (2.9), Opava (2.9), Jeseník (2.7). In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 11,963 vacancies for persons with reduced working capacity that is 3.0 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 60,290 vacancies, that is 0.3 seekers per vacancy.

**Unemployment rate** (EUROSTAT – ILO, NSA data) was **2.6 % in August 2022**.
