## Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by April 30, 2022

By April 30, 2022 job offices registered altogether 243,658 job seekers. That is by 9,215 less than at the end of March 2022. The number of job seekers decreased by 54,218 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 220,318.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 31,048 newcomers. That is by 391 job seekers less than in the preceding month and by 2,399 newly registered job seekers more than in April of the preceding year.

In April, job offices registration was terminated with 40,263 job seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 28,787 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 11,476 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly increase of unemployed was registered by 6 districts — Plzeň-město (1.2 %), Česká Lípa (1.1 %), Teplice (0.9 %), Praha-východ (0.7 %), Chomutov (0.3 %), Most (0.3 %).

A monthly decrease of unemployed was registered by 71 districts – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts - Jindřichův Hradec (13.8 %), Chrudim (12.5 %), Jeseník (12.5 %), Břeclav (12.0 %), Strakonice (11.9 %), Český Krumlov (11.8 %), Prachatice (9.8 %), Klatovy (9.8 %).

By April 30, 2022, 11,072 school leavers with all levels of education and juveniles were registered. Thus they share in the total unemployment by 4.5% (March 2022-4.5%, April 2021-4.2%).

At the end of April, job offices registered 128,713 female job seekers, that is 52.8 % of the unemployed in total, and 37,208 persons with reduced working capacity, that is 15.3 % of the unemployed in total.

In April 2022, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 75,336 job seekers, that is 30.9% of all job seekers under registration (March 2022 - 32.4%, April 2021 - 29.5%).

By April 30, 2022, there were 8,642 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.

By April 30, 2022, the share of unemployed was 3.3 % (March 2022 – 3.4 %, April 2021 – 4.1 %), time series - <a href="https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno">https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno</a>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 27 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.3 %), Most (6.7 %), Chomutov (6.4 %), Bruntál (6.0 %), Louny (5.8 %), Ústí nad Labem (5.5 %), Ostrava-město (5.4 %), Znojmo (5.0 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts Praha-východ (1.1 %), Praha-západ (1.5 %), Pelhřimov (1.5 %), Benešov (1.6 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.7 %), Jindřichův Hradec (1.8 %), Plzeň-jih (1.8 %), Jičín (1.9 %). Share of unemployed - men was 3.0 % and share of unemployed - women was 3.6 %.

By April 30, 2022, job offices registered altogether 344,350 vacancies. That is by 15,818 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 943 vacancies more than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.7 job seekers for one vacancy at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (9.7), Most (4.4), Bruntál (4.3), Ústí

nad Labem (3.7), Sokolov (3.1), Louny (2.9), Děčín (2.6), Jeseník (2.5). In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 12,824 vacancies for persons with reduced working capacity that is 2.9 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 65,867 vacancies, that is 0.2 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT - ILO, NSA data) was 2.3 % in March 2022.
