

Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by October 31, 2022

By October 31, 2022 job offices registered altogether 255,792 job seekers. That is by 588 less than at the end of September 2022. The number of job seekers increased by 4,103 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 231,728.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 38,161 newcomers. That is by 11,179 job seekers less than in the preceding month and by 7,965 newly registered job seekers more than in October of the preceding year.

In October, job offices registration was terminated with 38,749 job seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 25,673 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 13,076 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly increase of unemployed was registered **by 33 districts** — relatively the greatest increase was monitored in districts Jeseník (4.2 %), Česká Lípa (3.7 %), Jindřichův Hradec (3.7 %), Mladá Boleslav (3.6 %), Český Krumlov (3.1 %), Plzeň-sever (3.1 %), Hradec Králové (3.0 %), Karlovy Vary (2.4 %). **A monthly decrease of unemployed** was registered **by 43 districts** — relatively the greatest increase was monitored in districts Jičín (5.2 %), Rokycany (3.9 %), Domažlice (3.7 %), Rakovník (3.4 %), Žďár nad Sázavou (3.3 %), Plzeň-jih (3.1 %), Pelhřimov (3.0 %), Tachov (3.0 %).

By October 31, 2022, 15,117 school leavers with all levels of education **and juveniles were registered.** Thus they share in the total unemployment by 5.9 % (September 2022 – 6.0 %, October 2021 – 5.8 %).

At the end of October, job offices registered 142,589 female job seekers, that is 55.7 % of the unemployed in total, and **36,213 persons with reduced working capacity,** that is 14.2 % of the unemployed in total.

In October 2022, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 74,139 job seekers, that is 29.0 % of all job seekers under registration (September 2022 – 29.1 %, October 2021 – 28.9 %).

By October 31, 2022, there were 13,518 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.

By October 31, 2022, the share of unemployed was 3.5 % (September 2022 – 3.5 %, October 2021 – 3.4 %), time series - <https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 27 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.2 %), Most (6.7 %), Chomutov (6.1 %), Bruntál (5.8 %), Ústí nad Labem (5.8 %), Louny (5.4 %), Ostrava-město (5.2 %), Děčín (5.1 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts Praha-východ (1.5 %), Pelhřimov (1.7 %), Praha-západ (1.8 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.8 %), Benešov (1.9 %), Plzeň-jih (1.9 %), Zlín (2.0 %), Jindřichův Hradec (2.1 %).

Share of unemployed - men was 3.0 % and share of unemployed - women was 4.0 %.

By October 31, 2022, job offices registered altogether 297,360 vacancies. That is by 8,738 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 55,094 vacancies less than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.9 job seekers for one vacancy

at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (9.8), Ústí nad Labem (4.2), Bruntál (4.2), Most (4.1), Jeseník (3.2), Děčín (3.2), Opava (2.9), Sokolov (2.9). In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 11,419 vacancies for persons with reduced working capacity that is 3.2 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 58,872 vacancies, that is 0.3 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT – ILO, NSA data) was **2.2 % in September 2022**.
