

Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by June 30, 2022

By June 30, 2022 job offices registered altogether 231,309 job seekers. That is by 4,159 less than at the end of May 2022. The number of job seekers decreased by 41,993 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 208,196.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 30,851 newcomers. That is by 170 job seekers more than in the preceding month and by 2,388 newly registered job seekers more than in June of the preceding year.

In June, job offices registration was terminated with 35,010 job seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 22,140 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 12,870 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly increase of unemployed was registered **by 18 districts** — relatively the greatest increase was monitored in districts Pelhřimov (3.4 %), České Budějovice (2.0 %), Beroun (1.4 %), Brno-venkov (1.3 %), Strakonice (1.1 %), Klatovy (0.9 %), Plzeň-jih (0.9 %), Prachatice (0.9 %).

A monthly decrease of unemployed was registered **by 59 districts** – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts – Jeseník (11.8 %), Cheb (9.0 %), Písek (6.4 %), Karlovy Vary (5.5 %), Znojmo (5.3 %), Jindřichův Hradec (5.2 %), Chomutov (4.9 %), Domažlice (4.5 %).

By June 30, 2022, 8,999 school leavers with all levels of education **and juveniles were registered.** Thus they share in the total unemployment by 3.9 % (May 2022 – 4.5 %, June 2021 – 3.5 %).

At the end of June, job offices registered 126,535 female job seekers, that is 54.3 % of the unemployed in total, and **35,921 persons with reduced working capacity,** that is 15.5 % of the unemployed in total.

In June 2022, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 70,769 job seekers, that is 30.6 % of all job seekers under registration (May 2022 – 30.8 %, June 2021 – 27.5 %).

By June 30, 2022, there were 11,429 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.

By June 30, 2022, the share of unemployed was 3.1 % (May 2022 – 3.2 %, June 2021 – 3.7 %), time series - <https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 26 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.0 %), Most (6.5 %), Chomutov (5.9 %), Bruntál (5.5 %), Ústí nad Labem (5.3 %), Ostrava-město (5.2 %), Louny (5.2 %), Děčín (4.5 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts Praha-východ (1.1 %), Praha-západ (1.5 %), Pelhřimov (1.5 %), Benešov (1.6 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.6 %), Jindřichův Hradec (1.7 %), Plzeň-jih (1.8 %), Jičín (1.8 %). **Share of unemployed - men was 2.8 % and share of unemployed - women was 3.5 %.**

By June 30, 2022, job offices registered altogether 319,408 vacancies. That is by 17,923 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 36,204 vacancies less than in the

same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.7 job seekers for one vacancy at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (9.7), Ústí nad Labem (4.5 Bruntál (3.8),), Most (3.7), Sokolov (2.8), Děčín (2.7), Louny (2.4), Oprava (2.3).

In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 12,615 vacancies for persons with reduced working capacity that is 2.8 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 62,830 vacancies, that is 0.1 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT – ILO, NSA data) was **2.4 % in May 2022**.
