

Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by September 30, 2021

By September 30, 2021 job offices registered altogether 262,142 job seekers. That is by 5,747 less than at the end of August. The number of job seekers decreased by 14,873 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 241,635.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 42,935 newcomers. That is by 13,084 job seekers more than in the preceding month and by 7,939 newly registered job seekers less than in September of the preceding year.

In September, job offices registration was terminated with 48,682 job seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 33,520 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 15,162 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly decrease of unemployed was registered **by 63 districts** – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts Praha-východ (9.4 %), Praha-západ (7.8 %), Zlín (5.6 %), Tachov (5.1 %), Liberec (5.0 %), Tábor (4.9 %), České Budějovice (4.8 %), Jihlava (4.5 %). **A monthly increase of unemployed** was registered **by 14 districts** – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts Pelhřimov (10.1 %), Rokycany (4.8 %), Mladá Boleslav (4.5 %), Louny (1.9 %), Prachatice (1.7 %), Jičín (1.5 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.4 %), Jindřichův Hradec (1.0 %).

By September 30, 2021, 16,015 school leavers with all levels of education **and juveniles were registered.** Thus they share in the total unemployment by 6.1 % (August 2021 – 3.8 %, September 2020 – 5.8 %).

At the end of September, job offices registered 138,886 female job seekers, that is 53.0 % of the unemployed in total, and **38,129 persons with reduced working capacity,** that is 14.5 % of the unemployed in total.

In September 2021, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 74,957 job seekers, that is 28.6 % of all job seekers under registration (August 2021 – 29.4 %, September 2020 – 30.9 %).

By September 30, 2021, the share of unemployed was 3.5 % (August 2021 – 3.6 %, September 2020 – 3.8 %), time series - <https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 24 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.9 %), Most (6.8 %), Ostrava-město (6.3 %), Ústí nad Labem (6.1 %), Chomutov (6.1 %), Louny (5.7 %), Bruntál (5.7 %), Sokolov (5.2 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts of Praha-východ (1.5 %), Jindřichův Hradec (1.7 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.8 %), Jičín (1.8 %), Pelhřimov (1.9 %), Benešov (1.9 %), Prachatice (2.0 %), Praha-západ (2.0 %). **Share of unemployed - men was 3.3 % and share of unemployed - women was 3.9 %.**

By September 30, 2021, job offices registered altogether 357,911 vacancies. That is by 5,203 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 41,253 vacancies more than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.7 job seekers for one vacancy at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (10.1), Most (4.8), Ústí nad Labem (4.4), Sokolov (4.1), Bruntál (3.9), Ostrava-město (2.6), Děčín (2.5), Hodonín (2.4). In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 13,956 vacancies for persons with

reduced working capacity that is 2.7 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 64,167 vacancies, that is 0.2 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT – ILO, NSA data) was **3.0 % in August 2021**.
