## Information on Unemployment in the Czech Republic by November 30, 2021

By November 30, 2021 job offices registered altogether 245,549 job seekers. That is by 6,140 less than at the end of October. The number of job seekers decreased by 28,977 persons compared with the same period of the preceding year. The number of available job seekers in age 15 to 64 years (job seekers currently available for work) was 223,098.

In the course of job offices registered altogether 31,845 newcomers. That is by 1,649 job seekers more than in the preceding month and by 3,515 newly registered job seekers less than in November of the preceding year.

In November, job offices registration was terminated with 37,985 job seekers. New jobs have been taken up by 24,278 persons. In the course of the above-said month, job offices excluded 13,707 job seekers due to other reasons.

A monthly decrease of unemployed was registered by 60 districts – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts České Budějovice (6.7 %), Benešov (6.4 %), Praha (6.1 %), Praha-západ (5.7 %), Mělník (5.3 %), Cheb (5.2 %), Praha-východ (5.1 %), Pelhřimov (5.1 %). A monthly increase of unemployed was registered by 17 districts – relatively the greatest decrease was monitored in districts Jeseník (13.2 %), Jičín (7.5 %), Český Krumlov (6.3 %), Prachatice (5.4 %), Břeclav (4.7 %), Klatovy (4.6 %), Jindřichův Hradec (3.5 %), Znojmo (2.8 %).

By November 30, 2021, 12,993 school leavers with all levels of education and juveniles were registered. Thus they share in the total unemployment by 5.3% (October 2021 -5.8%, November 2020-5.1%).

At the end of November, job offices registered 129,412 female job seekers, that is 52.7 % of the unemployed in total, and 37,262 persons with reduced working capacity, that is 15.2 % of the unemployed in total.

In November 2021, job offices paid off unemployment benefits 73,463 job seekers, that is 29.9% of all job seekers under registration (October 2021 - 28.9%, November 2020 - 32.3%).

By November 30, 2021, there were 15,149 jobseekers supported through financial benefits of active employment policy.

By November 30, 2021, the share of unemployed was 3.3 % (October 2021 – 3.4 %, November 2020 – 3.8 %), time series - <a href="https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno.">https://www.mpsv.cz/web/cz/casove-rady-mn-a-pno</a>. Share of unemployed equal or higher than average of the Czech Republic was shown in 27 districts, the highest being in Karviná (8.4 %), Most (6.2 %), Chomutov (5.8 %), Ostrava-město (5.6 %), Bruntál (5.6 %), Ústí nad Labem (5.6 %), Louny (5.5 %), Sokolov (4.7 %). The lowest share of unemployed was in districts Praha-východ (1.3 %), Pelhřimov (1.6 %), Benešov (1.6 %), Rychnov nad Kněžnou (1.6 %), Praha-západ (1.8 %), Jindřichův Hradec (1.8 %), Jičín (2.0 %), Ústí nad Orlicí (2.0 %). Share of unemployed - men was 3.0 % and share of unemployed - women was 3.5 %.

By November 30, 2021, job offices registered altogether 344,840 vacancies. That is by 7,614 vacancies less than in the preceding month and by 26,868 vacancies more than in the same period of the preceding year. At present, there have been 0.7 job seekers for one vacancy

at average, the highest amount being in districts of Karviná (9.9), Most (4.6), Ústí nad Labem (4.4), Bruntál (3.9), Sokolov (3.6), Znojmo (3.3), Ostrava-město (2.6), Děčín (2.5). In this monitored period, there were registered by job offices 13,242 vacancies for persons with reduced working capacity that is 2.8 seekers per vacancy. In the case of school leavers and juveniles, there were registered altogether 62,856 vacancies, that is 0.2 seekers per vacancy.

Unemployment rate (EUROSTAT - ILO, NSA data) was 2.6 % in October 2021.
